


# How to prepare geometry for exporting DXF from EasySTONE into Slabsmith

*To prepare geometry for Slabsmith, it will need to be “re-pathed”.*

**Take these actions:**

- Select all
- In drawing menu click on “Elaborate” tab
- Click “Adjust path”
- Set the “Approx” to 0.0001
- Click “OK” and the geometry is now ready to export to Slabsmith as a DXF
